Guidance for PTA Inclusivity in Action Award nominations:

This award celebrates PTAs that actively ensure every child and family feels welcome, valued and able to participate fully in school life. It recognises PTAs that go above and beyond to support pupils with SEND/ALN and long-term health conditions by removing barriers, adapting activities, improving communications and working collaboratively to create inclusive opportunities for all families.

Your nomination should demonstrate clear evidence of:

- Inclusive planning and delivery of events and activities
- Accessible and inclusive communication
- Collaboration with the wider community
- Representation, voice and lived experience shaping decisions
- Practical support through funding, equipment or facilities
- Measurable and meaningful impact on pupils and families

Please note: PTAs do not need to meet every criterion equally, but should provide clear, relevant evidence where applicable.
