England responses - November 2020

Detail of the research

A short online survey, promoted to parents via social media, was active between 22nd October and 4th November 2020. 624 parents completed the survey of which 405 were based in England, 191 in Northern Ireland and 28 in Wales. **These results are from parents based in England only**. Parents with more than one child were invited to answer some of the questions again for their second child's experiences. Please note percentages may not add up to 100% due to don't knows and rounding.



To what extent is your child getting the support they need to catch up on the face to face learning missed last spring and summer?








Does your child have access to a device with internet access which they can use for remote learning?

Has your child's school shared details this term of how they will continue to educate your child if/when they have (had) to stay at home?






