

The ultimate PGL summer adventure at home

Bring a little bit of the PGL adventure home this summer with one of the exciting activities children love most at camp. Cut out these adventure cards and choose one to create an adventure on the spot this summer



1 Big drop challenge

Teams build a protective container using simple recycled materials (such as cereal boxes, wrapping paper and bubble wrap) to keep a chocolate egg or water balloon safe when dropped from a height.

2 Magic carpet challenge

Challenge your family to flip a picnic blanket completely over without stepping off it, relying on balance and teamwork.

3 Human knot

Players grab hands across a circle and work together to untangle themselves back into a full circle without letting go. This one is perfect for a playdate with another family!

4 Minefield

One blindfolded player navigates a field of obstacles guided only by the spoken instructions of their teammates.

5 Cardboard boat building

Divide into teams and design and build boats from cardboard and recycling materials, then test whether they float or sink.

6 Dog, chicken and corn

The group helps a “farmer” transport three items across a river without leaving incompatible pairs together.

7 The market

When going to market, you are only allowed to buy certain items (in this case it would be something starting with the letter your name starts with), and you must work out the rule of what you are allowed to buy by taking it in turns to guess. The first person starts with a correct example “My Name is Jade. I went to market, and I brought Jam.” Everyone must then repeat the sentence using their own names and the item they would like to buy.

8 Bridge builders

Teams construct a bridge from limited materials and test how much weight it can hold before it collapses.
